# Food Ideas!

## Gingerbread

- 350g Plain Flour
- 175g light brown sugar
- 100g unsalted butter
  - 1 Egg -Beaten
- 1 teaspoon of baking soda
- 1 teaspoon of ground ginger
- 4 tablespoons of golden syrup



1. Sieve the flour, spices and baking soda in a large mixing bowl. Chop the butter into pieces and rub into the flour then mix in the sugar.
2. Add in the egg and syrup and mix into the dough.
3. Wrap the dough in cling film and pop into the fridge for an hour.
4. Roll out your gingerbread onto a floured surface, cut out your biscuits and pop them onto a baking tray.
5. Bake in the oven at 180c for 10-15 minutes until they are golden brown.
6. Leave to cool and then DECORATE!!
